## TRUTH SERIES TRAUMA PLATES

### Care and Maintenance

Your trauma plate is an important part of your safety equipment. It should be cared for and worn properly in order for it to function as designed. Follow these Care and Maintenance instructions to ensure the ballistic integrity of your trauma plate is not degraded.

#### STORAGE

When you are not using your trauma plate, it should be stored under normal environmental conditions. Storage at room temperature is recommended. Do not store in a vehicle where it could be exposed to temperatures exceeding 130 - 150°F.

#### CLEANING

- Wipe clean with a mild soap and water solution
- Wipe dry and allow to sit in a cool dry location until fully dry
- Do not wash, machine dry, dry clean or sun dry
- Do not use abrasive cleansers or scrub pads
- Do not use Bleach, Ammonia or other harsh detergents or cleaners as they may compromise the performance, seal and/or exterior graphics

#### MAINTENANCE & USE

- Be sure that your trauma plate is secure and in the proper carrier pocket, as determined by Angel Armor or the vest manufacturer
- Do not store sharp objects near this product while in carrier as they may impede performance or cause undue bodily injury in the event of an impact
- This product is meant to be used in conjunction with an NIJ 06 Level IIA or higher vest
- Like all ballistic armor, this trauma plate cannot protect you against every threat you face
- Always refer to the product label to determine the protection level of your trauma plate; if label is not legible or missing, contact Angel Armor immediately at [service@angelarmor.com](mailto:service@angelarmor.com)
